


What if I have not chosen my health care agent?

Washington State law lists who will make health care decisions for you if you cannot

The order for who will decide is:



A guardian with health care decision-making authority, if one has been appointed by the state



The agent named with health care decisionmaking authority in the advance directive



Your spouse or registered domestic partner (even if separated)



Your adult children *



Your parents *



Your adult brothers and sisters *



*Any group that has more than one person: all in the group must agree to the care
